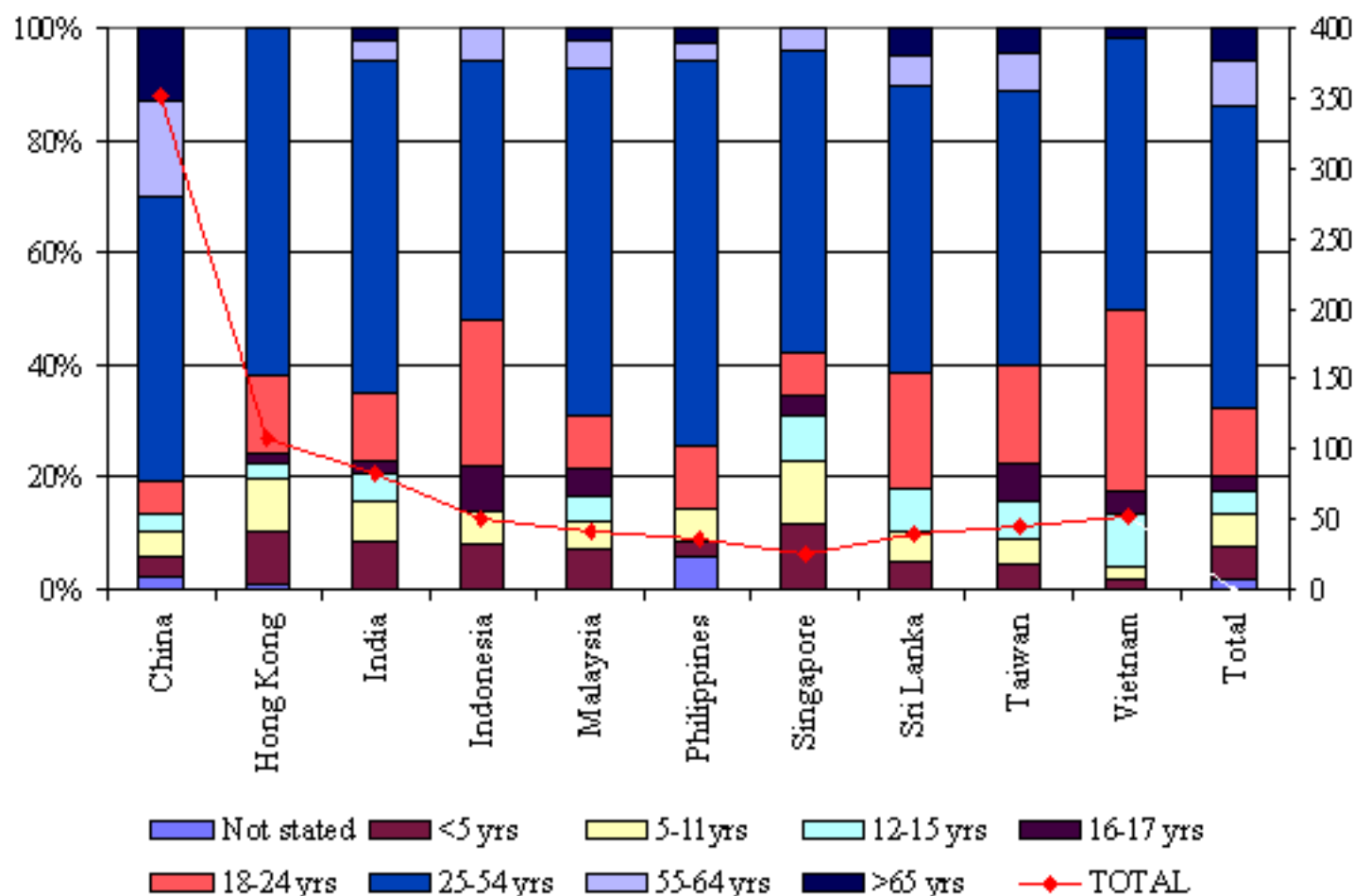


6.9 Age distribution of the 10 largest migrant groups settling between 1996 and 1999

53% of migrants (excluding humanitarian entrants) settling in Whitehorse were aged between 25 and 54 years. For people born in the Philippines this percentage was 69% and for those born in Malaysia 62%. People born in China were the largest migrant group with 352 people settling in Whitehorse. Within this 51% of people were aged 25 - 54 years, 17% aged between 55 - 64 years, 13% aged over 65 years and 6% aged 18 - 24 years.
