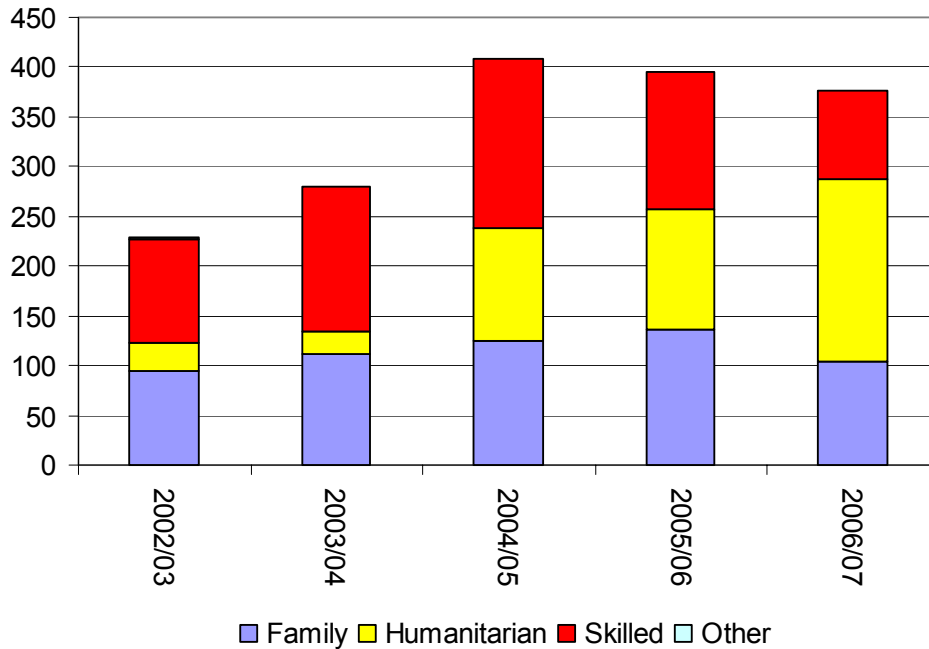

## Settlement in the City of Maroondah by Migration Stream July 1 2002 to June 2007<sup>1</sup>



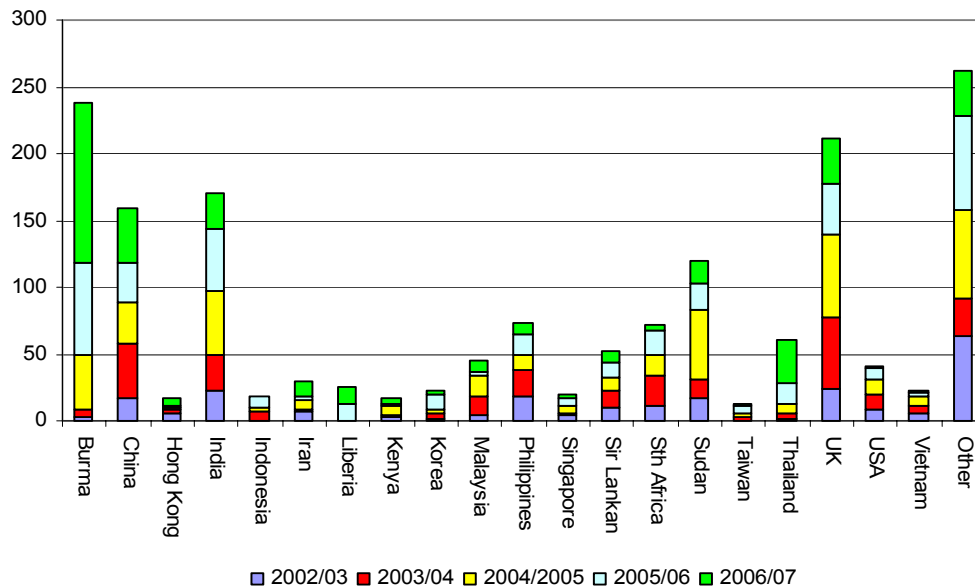
Over 1600 people have settled in the City of Maroondah in the period July 1 2002 to June 30 2007 which represented 5% of all people settling in the Eastern Region. The largest number 24% (409) of people entered in 2004/2005.

Thirty three percent (471) of all humanitarian entrants settling in the Eastern Region settled in the City of Maroondah.

The largest number 38% (647) of all entrants in the City settled under the Skilled Migration program, followed by 44% (570) under the Family Migration Program and 28% (471) under the Humanitarian program.

## Settlement by Country of Birth - July 1 2002 to June 30 2007<sup>2</sup>



The largest community settling in the City of Maroondah were born in Burma (238). In 2006/07 32% (119) of all new entrants were born in Burma. Sixty eight percent (238) of all people born in Burma who settled in the Eastern Region settled in the City of Maroondah.

Fourteen percent (238) of all new settlers in the five years ending June 2007 were born in Burma, 9% (159) were born in China, 12% (211) were born in the United Kingdom and 10% (170) were born in India.

## Languages spoken by residents in the City of Maroondah<sup>3</sup>.

- There is a total population of 99202 people living in the City of Maroondah. 87% (86411) of these speak English at home whilst 9% (8759) do not speak English at home.<sup>4</sup> The number of people who do not speak English at home has risen by 1% (672) since the ABS Census of 2001.
- Ninety six languages are spoken at home by people residing in Maroondah.
- The largest number of people speaking a language other than English speak Italian (977) this is a 8% (83) decrease in the number of Italian speakers from the ABS Census of 2001. The number of people speaking the second largest language group (other than English), German, has also decreased 11% (66) to 546. The third largest language group other than English is Cantonese where the number of people speaking Cantonese at home has increased by 8% (45) since the last census in 2001.
- A number of new communities have settled in Maroondah since the 2001 Census. The Burmese born community has increased from 3 people in 2001 to 75 in the 2006 Census. A further 119 people settled from Burma in the year ending June 2007. There were no Dinka or Nuer speakers recorded in the 2001 census, in 2006 85 and 32 people respectively were recorded as speaking these two languages.
- The Mandarin speaking community has increased since the ABS Census of 2001 by 57% (197) to 545 people and the Arabic speaking community has increased by 20% (53) to 324 people. The Hindi speaking community has also increased by 42% (76) to 256 people and the Punjabi speaking community has increased by 101% (68) to 135 people.
- The Nuer and Dinka speaking communities have the largest percentage of the community aged 18 years or less with 66%(21) and 55% (47) respectively in this age group. Twenty one percent (138) of the Cantonese speaking and 24% (132) of the Mandarin speaking communities are in this age group. Across the Eastern Region 24% (230614) of the population is in the age group and in the City of Maroondah 25% (24837) people are aged 10 years or less.
- Fourteen percent (12119) of people who speak English at home are aged between 19 and 29 years, for people who speak a language other than English at home 13% (1172) of the population is in this age group. Eight percent (76) of the Italian, 11% (71) of the Cantonese, 16% (89) of the Mandarin, 12% (64) of the Greek and 16% (59) of the Spanish speaking communities are in this age group. Across the region as a whole 15% (140963) of the population is in this age cohort.
- Twenty nine percent (25335) of Maroondah's population who speaks English at home and 33% (2891) of the population who speaks a language other than English at home are aged between 30 and 49 years. Twenty nine percent (274391) of the region's total population is aged between 30 and 49 years. Thirty percent (318) of the Italian, 26% (224) of the Cantonese, 32% (126) of the German, 14% (227) of the Mandarin and 25% (207) of the Greek speaking communities are in this age group.
- Ten percent (97784) of the total regional population is aged 70 years or over. In the City of Maroondah 10 percent (8395) of the population who speak English at home and 12% (1045) of the population who speaks a language other than English at home are aged 70 years or more. In the Arabic speaking communities 3% (10) of the community in this age group, 6% (40) of the Cantonese, 33% (180) of the

German, 21% (208) of the Italian, 20% (32) of the Hungarian, 8% (45) of the Greek, 45% (172) of the Dutch, 19% (58) of the Polish are in this age group.

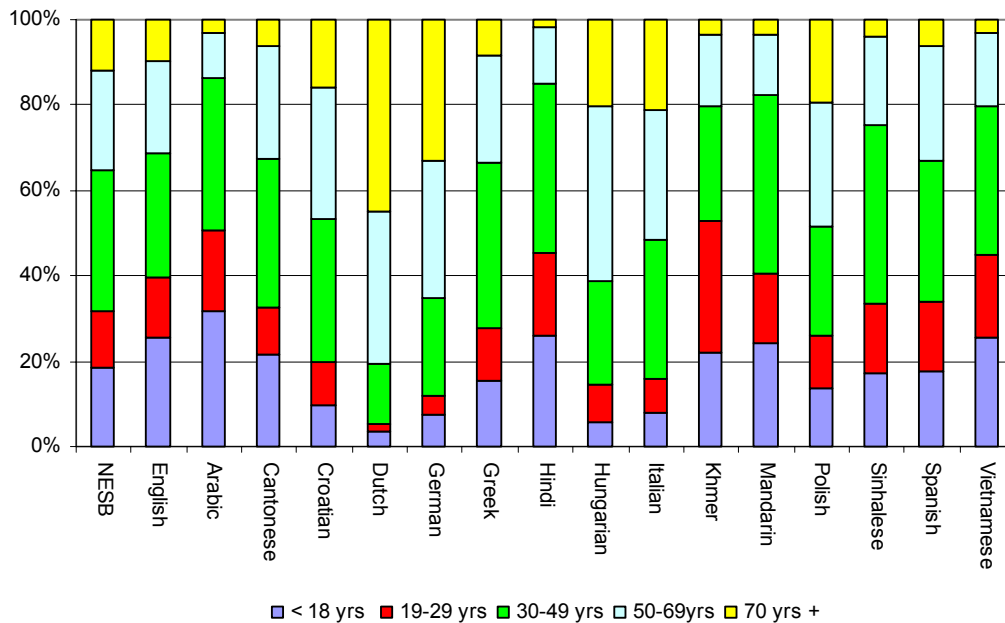

The largest percentage, 33% (318) of the Italian speaking community is aged between thirty and forty - nine years. People who speak Italian at home are the largest language group speaking a language other than English at home. The second largest population speaking a language other than English at home is the Cantonese speaking, again the largest percentage, and 35% (224) of this community is aged between 30 and 49 years. In some newly arrived communities the largest percentage of people are aged less than 18 years. For example in the Nuer speaking community 66% (21) and in the Dinka speaking community 55% (47), Karen 46% (19) and the Korean 44% (26) of the community is aged less than 18 years.

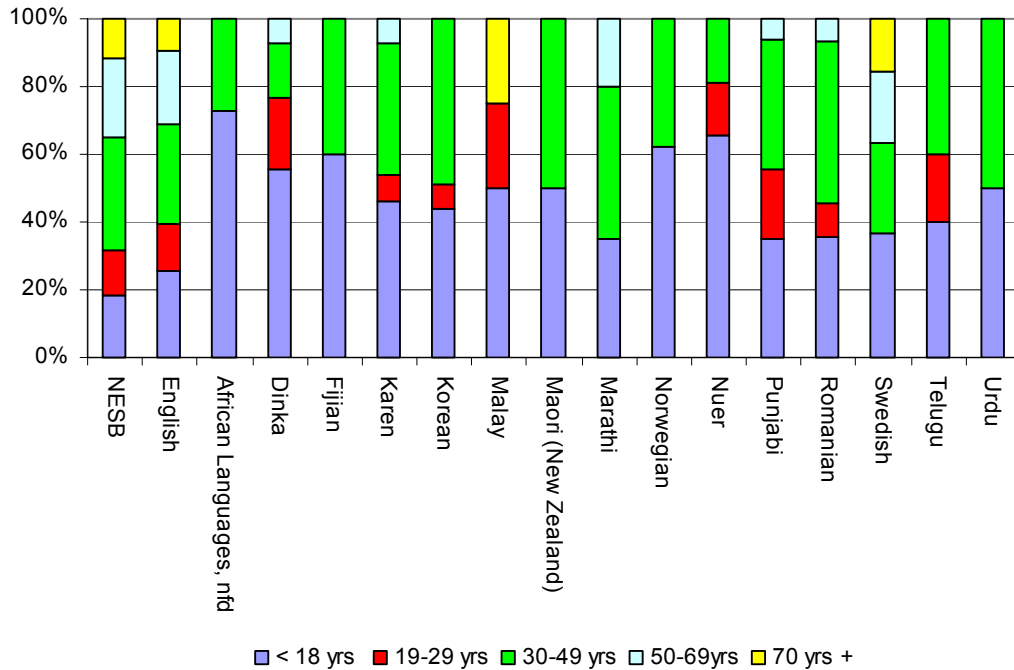
Sixteen percent (89) of the Mandarin speaking community, 19% (61) of the Arabic, 11% (71) of the Cantonese, 19% of the Vietnamese (67) and the Hindi (49) speaking communities are aged between 19 and 29 years. Across the region as a whole 15% (140963) of the population is in this age cohort.

Forty two percent (227) of the Mandarin speaking community are aged between 30 and 49 years. Twenty nine percent (274391) of the total regional population is in this age group. Thirty nine percent (207) of the Greek, 14% (54) of the Dutch, 40% (102) of the Hindi and 35% (121) of the Vietnamese speaking communities are in this age cohort.

Thirty percent (297) of the Italian speaking community are aged between 50 and 69 years. Across the region 22% (213054) of the total population is in this age cohort. Twenty six percent (170) of the Cantonese speaking community, 32% (176) of the German and 41% (65) of the Hungarian speaking communities are in this age group.

Ten percent (97784) of the total regional population is aged 70 years or over. In the Arabic speaking communities 3% (10) of the community in this age group, 6% (40) of the Cantonese, 45% (172) of the Dutch, 33% (180) of the German, 8% (45) of the Greek, 20% (32) of the Hungarian, 21% (208) of the Italian and 19% (58) of the Polish speaking communities are in this age group.

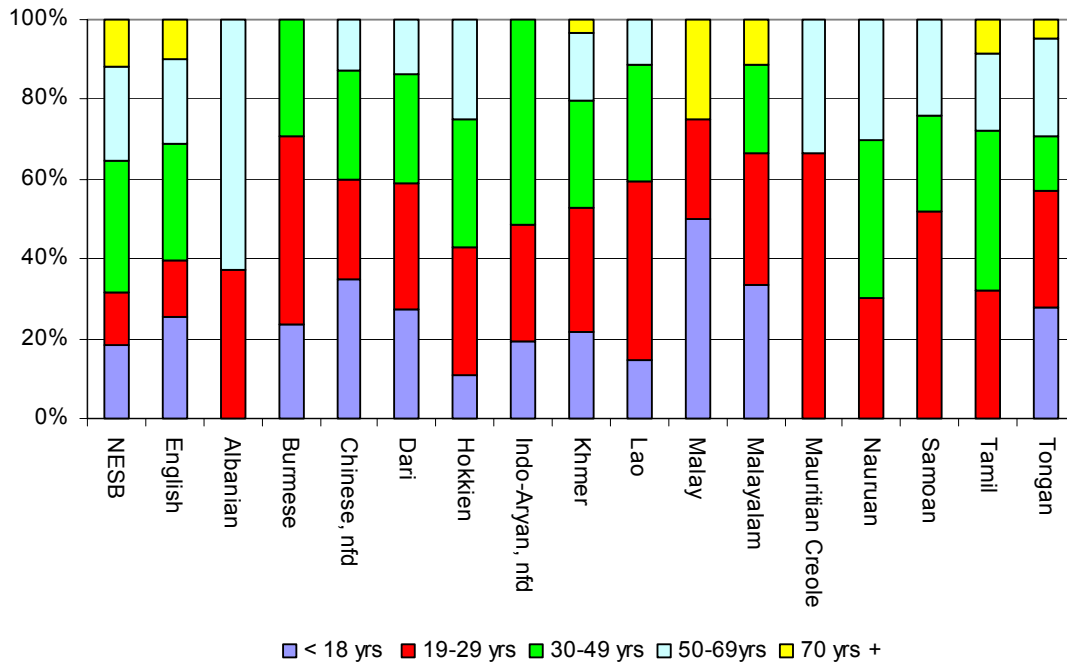
**Fifteen language groups with the highest percentage of their population under 18 years of age in the City of Maroondah**



In the City of Maroondah 26% (22136) of the people who speak English at home are aged less than 18 years. For people who speak a language other than English at home 18% (1607) of the population is in this age cohort. Across the region 24% (230614) of the population is under the age of 18 years.

The African languages where no further definition was given have 73% (8) of their community aged less than 18 years. The Nuer speaking community has 60% (33) of the community in this age group. Fifty five percent (47) of Dinka and 45% (19) of the Karen speaking community is in this age cohort, 60% (15) of the Fijian, 44% (26) of the Korean and 35% (47) of the Punjabi speaking communities are also aged less than 18 years.

**Fifteen language groups with the highest percentage of their population aged between 19 and 29 years in the City of Maroondah**

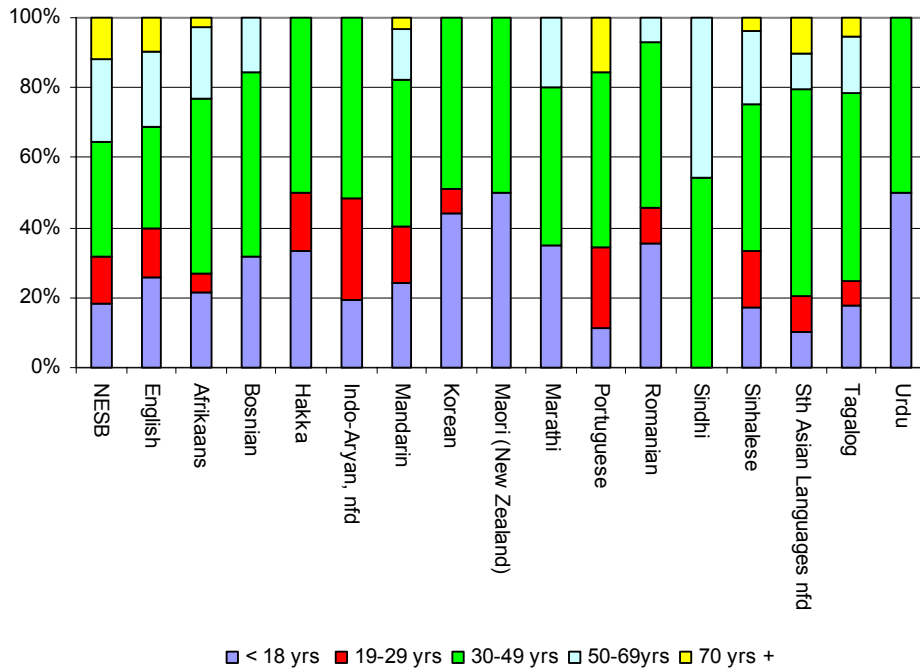


Fourteen percent (12119) of people who speak English at home are aged between 19 and 29 years. For people who speak a language other than English at home 13% (1172) of the population is in this age group. Forty seven percent (16) of people who recorded they spoke Burmese at home are in this age group, 33% (9) of the Malayalam, and 32% (9) of the Hokkien, Tamil (15) and Dari (7) speaking communities are in this age cohort.

In larger communities 8% (76) of the Italian, 11% (71) of the Cantonese, 16% (89) of the Mandarin, 12% (64) of the Greek and 16% (59) of the Spanish speaking communities are in this age group.

Across the region as a whole 15% (140963) of the population is in this age cohort.

**Fifteen language groups with the highest percentage of their population aged between 30 and 49 years in the City of Maroondah**

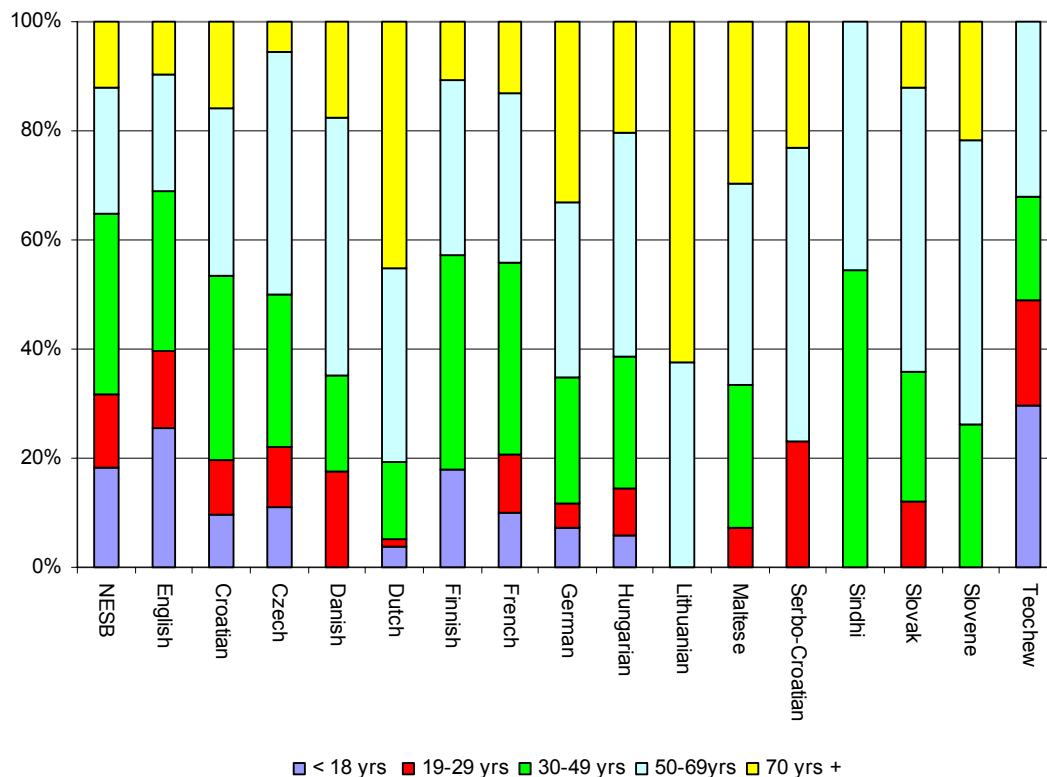


Twenty nine percent (25335) of Maroondah’s population who speaks English at home and 33% (2891) of the population who speaks a language other than English at home are aged between 30 and 49 years. Twenty nine percent (274391) of the region’s total population is aged between 30 and 49 years.

In the Tagalog speaking community 54% (19) of the community is in this age group and 50% (13) of the Portuguese, Hakka (9) and Afrikaans, (60) Maori (6), and Urdu (7) speaking communities are aged between 30 and 49 years.

In larger communities 30% (318) of the Italian, 26% (224) of the Cantonese, 32% (126) of the German, 14% (227) of the Mandarin and 25% (207) of the Greek speaking communities are in this age group.

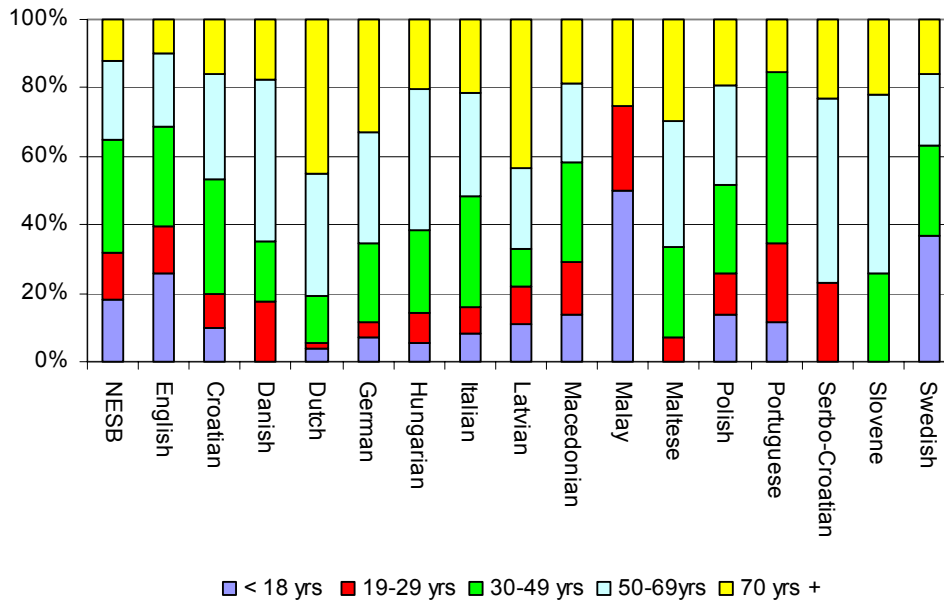
**Fifteen language groups with the highest percentage of their population aged between 50 and 69 years in the City of Maroondah**



Twenty one percent (18456) of the community who speaks English at home are aged 50 to 69 years in the population who speaks a language other than English at home 23% (2044) are in this age cohort. Across the region 22% (213054) of the total population is in this age cohort.

Thirty percent (297) of the Italian speaking community are aged between 50 and 69 years. Twenty six percent (170) of the Cantonese speaking community, 32% (176) of the German and 41% (65) of the Hungarian speaking communities are in this age group. In newer communities a much small percentage of the population is in this age group. For example in the Dinka (6) and Karen (3) speaking communities 7% of the communities population in aged between 50 and 69 years and in the Nuer speaking community there is no one aged over 49 years.

In the Arabic speaking communities 3% (10) of the community is in this age group, 6% (40) of the Cantonese, 33% (180) of the German, 21% (208) of the Italian, 20% (32) of the Hungarian, 8% (45) of the Greek, 45% (172) of the Dutch and 19% (58) of the Polish are in this age group.
