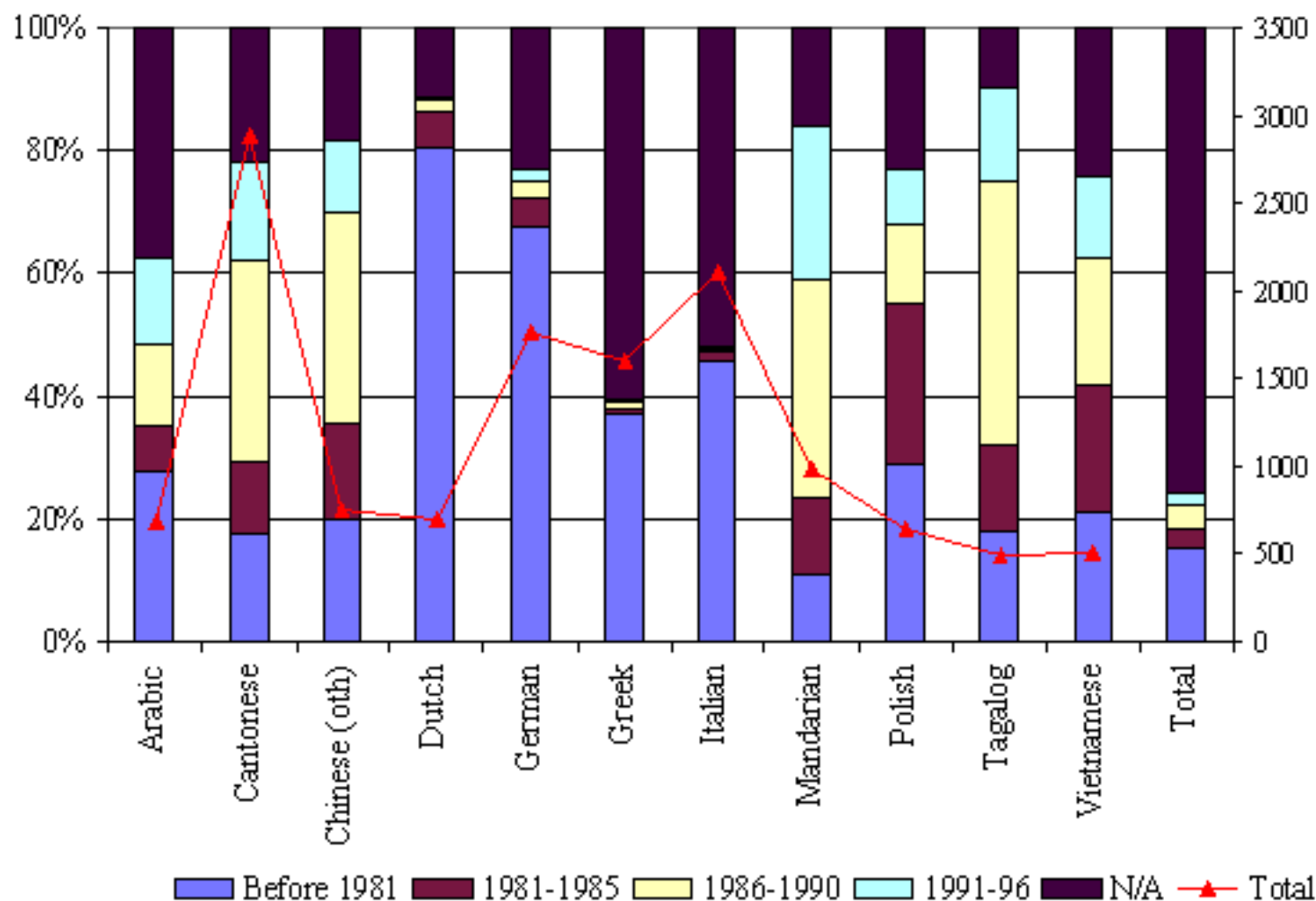

The majority of northern European migrants settled in Australia prior to 1981 with 67% of German and 80% of Dutch speaking people settling in this period. A further 23% of German and 11% of Dutch speaking people were born in Australia. Migrants speaking Chinese languages primarily settled in the 10 year period ending 1996.
